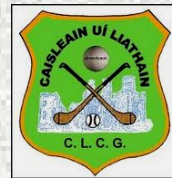

- The Tidy Towns Group has suspended their work evenings for this year. We wish to thank everyone who came out on the Tues Cleanup nights. Your support and help was greatly appreciated and we had some very enjoyable evenings.
- We gained 4 points in the National Tidy Towns Competition, going from 283 points last year to 287 points this year. We increased one point each in the following areas: Overall Development Approach, Landscaping, Wildlife and Natural Amenities and Road, Streets and Back Areas. The adjudicator stated 'that there is a great sense of pride of place that permeates throughout the community.' Each year this is a Community effort and we wish to thank everyone who in their own way helps to keep our villages and surrounding areas to such a high standard.
