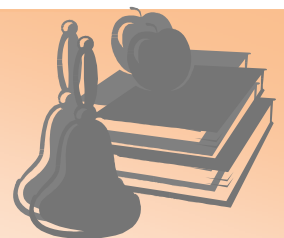
Hospice Fundraiser
