### “Tidy Towns Tips”

#### **Can I Recycle Polystyrene?**

Polystyrene is fully recyclable and can be recycled at your local recycling centre. Aero board is made from polystyrene, which is a form of plastic. This means that it can be recycled, but needs to be recycled in the correct way. You will be able to bring it to your local recycling centre for recycling.

#### **Can I Recycle Aerosol Cans?**

Aerosol cans can go into your household recycling bin, once they are empty and the lids are off. Do not pierce the cans or damage them in any way.
